

How to try out the beacons – Apple Instructions (iPad, iPhone)



You need an iPhone 4S or iPad 3 or newer, running at least iOS 8. Older iPhones and iPads, sadly, won't work. Newer iPhones or iPads should all be fine. If you have an older device, you should turn over this sheet and use the QR codes instead.

1) Install the Physical Web App:

Either search in the App Store for 'Physical Web'. The icon looks like this:



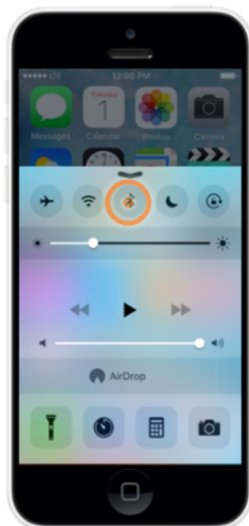
Or open your phone's browser and go to:

Once in the App store, click 'Get', then 'Install'

2) Make sure your phone's Bluetooth connection is On:

- a. Slide up from the bottom of the screen to bring up the control panel



- b. Tap the  icon if it is black. If it is white, Bluetooth is already on.

3) Launch the Physical Web app by selecting 'Open' or touching the icon from your home screen

4) To refresh the list of beacons, pull down on the list of beacons. For now, please don't use the option 'show example beacons' as there are real beacons nearby!

Please go to the 'test beacon' that we've put near the font (towards the back of the church) and refresh the list of beacons (you may need to wait a while to receive the signal) – if you can't see the test beacon, something might be wrong – ask a volunteer)

Now go and explore! There are 14 beacons in total, including the test beacon.

Please try to use your own 3G or 4G data connection. If that doesn't work, we have set up some temporary WiFi hotspots. These are called "GSM Beacons" and the password is "historyworks"
