If you do, then read this:

**You need to know that keeping children and young people safe is your
responsibility**

**If you have any concerns that a child or young person is being harmed
or harming themselves,**

**Or is otherwise at risk, you must always report it to your Line Manager
and if they are not available one of the Designated Persons (DP).**
